Committees are comprised of elected members of the Board of Education, school personnel, parents, other residents, and members of the business community.

Listed below is a brief description of each committee and its function. Community members serve for a one-year term and need to reapply each school year. All committees are advisory and report to the Board of Education. Committees vote on their recommendations to the Board, but it is the Board who takes final, formal action.

**Community Relations:** Creates and executes initiatives to improve public support and awareness of educational opportunities. Efforts include assisting at community events, and initiating activities that strengthen communications among all segments of the community.

**Curriculum and Programs:** Reviews curriculum, texts, and programs in order to recommend Board adoption, carefully considering the issues and research related to the education of all children.

**Fiscal Planning and Operations:** Ensures resources are allocated and utilized in accordance with the Board's short and long term educational and operational goals and objectives.

**Legislative/Policy:** Develops and revises board policies as mandated by law or required for the daily operation of the district. Efforts include addressing issues with public officials.

**School Culture and Climate:** Works in partnership with all stakeholders in the Piscataway School District to improve the positive expectations (Culture) and the overall appearance and feeling (Climate) of all schools. Piscataway strives to promote a positive, healthy learning environment for all students. Areas of focus include safety, morale, appearance of buildings and grounds, as well as parent and community involvement.
