Good Afternoon Piscataway Families,

I hope this message finds you well, and that you are able to relax a bit and enjoy your summer as we prepare for the school year. As a parent myself, I understand the anxiety many of you may feel regarding the process of your children going back to school this fall.

We are ahead of schedule and submitted our educational return plan to the Middlesex County Department of Education for approval. Hopefully, we will be able to release the full plan by the end of this week. I just wanted to update you on a new development. This past Friday the NJDOE released guidance for parents to have an "all remote learning option" for their children. You can find that document here.

There is no need to contact anyone at this time. I know many of you will need to see the specifics of our plan prior to making any decisions for your children. And you may need to ask further questions. This is information so you are fully informed and can begin to consider all your options. After our full plan is released, we will contact you with further information about the plan option process.

Counseling Available During Summer Months
