According to our Code of Conduct, responses to behavior infractions include the following:

- Counseling
- Peer Mediation
- Community Service
- Teacher Detention
- Central Detention
- Extended Wednesday Detention
- ICE – Isolated Classroom Experience
- In-School Suspension (where possible)
- Short-Term Suspension – 1-10 days
- Long-Term Suspension – 10+ days
- Transfer
- Expulsion
- Alternative Education Placement
