



Does Piscataway offer preschool?

The district offers several preschool options at Children's Corner Preschool tailored to meet the needs of Piscataway families. The Children's Corner Preschool program is based on the Tools of the Mind curriculum and includes free, grant-funded programs, and a preschool program for the disabled.

- Full-day programs for both three-year-olds and four-year-olds are available.
- Classes for three-year-olds and four-year-olds are offered at two Piscataway campuses:
 - Children's Corner by the River at 2300 Cooper Street (former St. Frances Cabrini School).
 - Children's Corner by the Pond at 499 New Market Road (former Our Lady of Fatima School).
- A full day tuition-based toddler program is offered for children ages 18-months to three-years-old.
- An infant program for children ages 6 weeks to 18-months prepares children to transition into the toddler program.
 - The Infant and toddler programs are offered at the 2300 Cooper Street campus only.
- Online registration for all programs begins in April for the following September. Wait lists are available after all openings are filled.
- The free, grant-funded program provides full-day preschool to Piscataway residents whose child will be three or four-year-old by October 1.
- Children with disabilities are included to the maximum extent possible with peers in their age-group.
