

Where do I register my child and what do I need to bring?

- Begin the registration process online: Go to www.piscatawayschools.org and click on "Enrollment Center" under "Quick Links" on the right side of the page.
- Once you have completed steps one and two online, finalize the enrollment process by scheduling an appointment at the Enrollment Center in the Piscataway Board of Education Administration Building, 1515 Stelton Road, at 732-572-2289, extension 2528. If you do not have online access, please call the Enrollment Center for assistance. Registrations are by appointment only.
- Bring proof of residency; proof of support (if applicable); an original birth certificate or passport; and proof of completed immunizations mandated by the State of New Jersey.
- Transferring students should bring a transfer card from the previous school; a copy of his/her report card; and standardized test scores.
- A parent/legal guardian must accompany any student registering to attend a Piscataway Township School.

Proof of Residency/Support – parent/guardian must provide proof of legal residency with one of the following documents:

- FOR THE HOMEOWNER Current mortgage statement, deed.
- Current quarterly property tax bill or current sewer tax statement.
- **FOR THE RENTER Current** copy of your lease, rental contract or notarized letter from landlord.

You must provide one item from the list below:

- Driver's License with a Piscataway address.
- State or work ID with a Piscataway address.
- Current Utility Bills (such as PSE&G, cable, water).
- Miscellaneous bills (such as a bank statement, medical bills, etc.). Advertisements will not be accepted.
