B. APPROVAL OF CONTRACTED SERVICES WITH COLLEGE BOARD/ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM/AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDIES PILOT

Explanation:

The Piscataway Township Schools currently participates in College Board's Advanced Placement Program, which gives students the opportunity to engage in college-level work while still in high school, potentially earning college credit and placement.

In addition to our current offerings, Piscataway High School has been invited by the College Board to participate in an African American Studies Pilot, which is a significant step in acknowledging the field of African American Studies. Moreover, the AP African American Studies Pilot will also offer another opportunity for engaging students in grades 9-12 who are often underrepresented in AP Classes.
