



What are some of the district's special education instructional programs and services?

The Board of Education offers a range of special education programs and services, including:

- Programming within the general education classroom with supplementary aid and services.
- Resource programs provided in class or as pull-out programs.
- Self-contained programs with opportunities for inclusion in academic and non-academic programs.
- Occasionally, home instruction or an "out of district" program may be warranted.

Related services are provided as recommended by the Child Study Team/IEP Team – the following are included:

- Speech and/or language therapy.
- Counseling.
- Occupational therapy.
- Physical therapy.
- Nursing services.
- Transportation services, etc.
